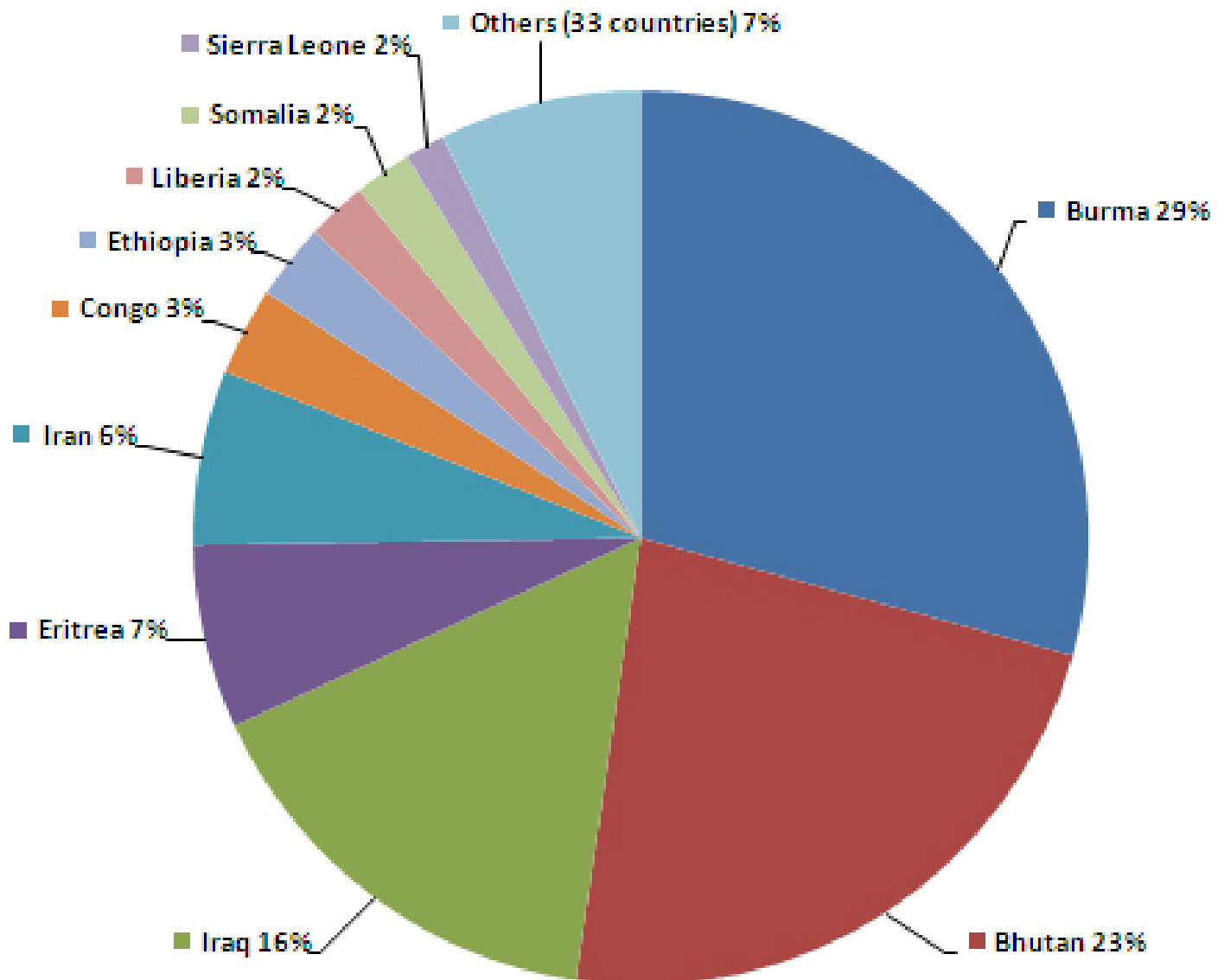

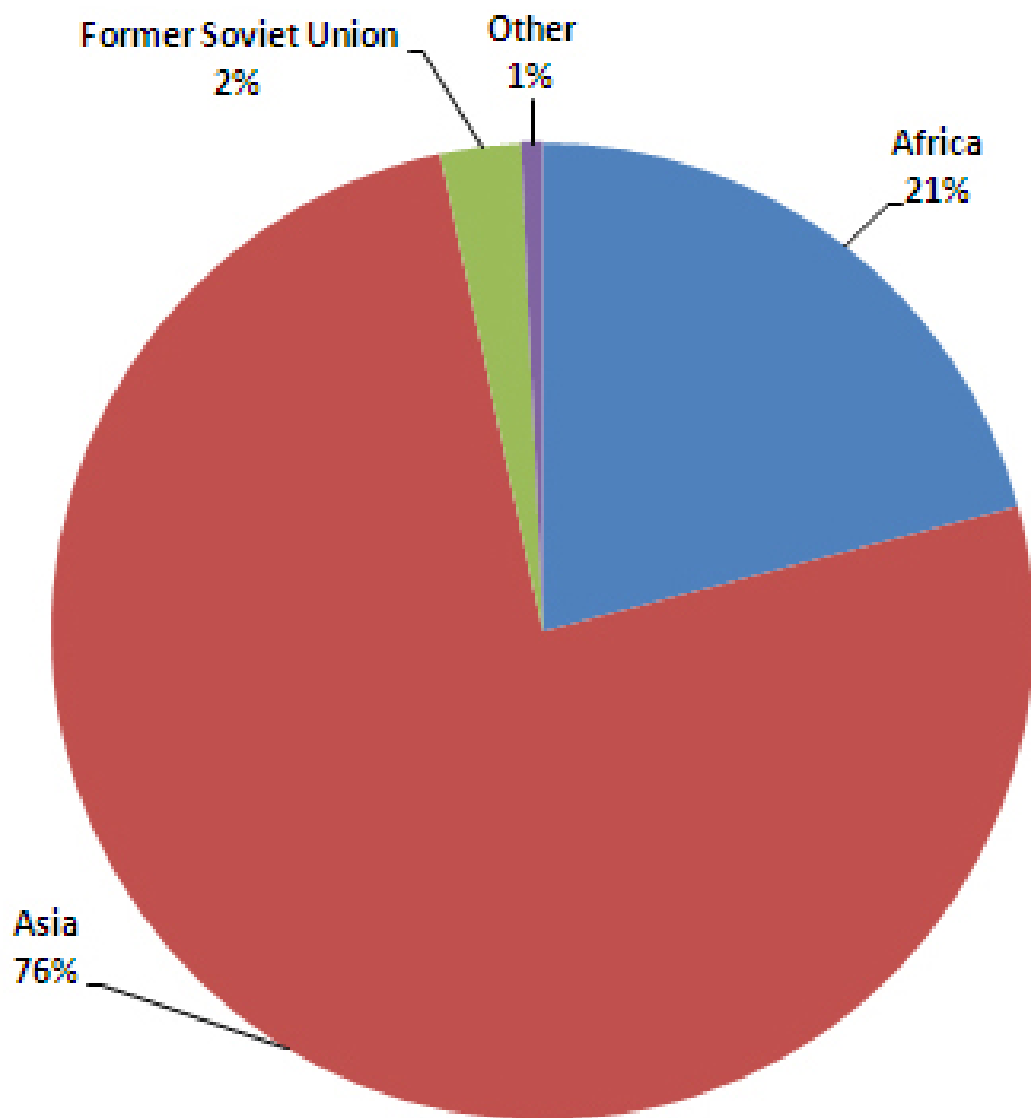

FY 2007 - FY 2011

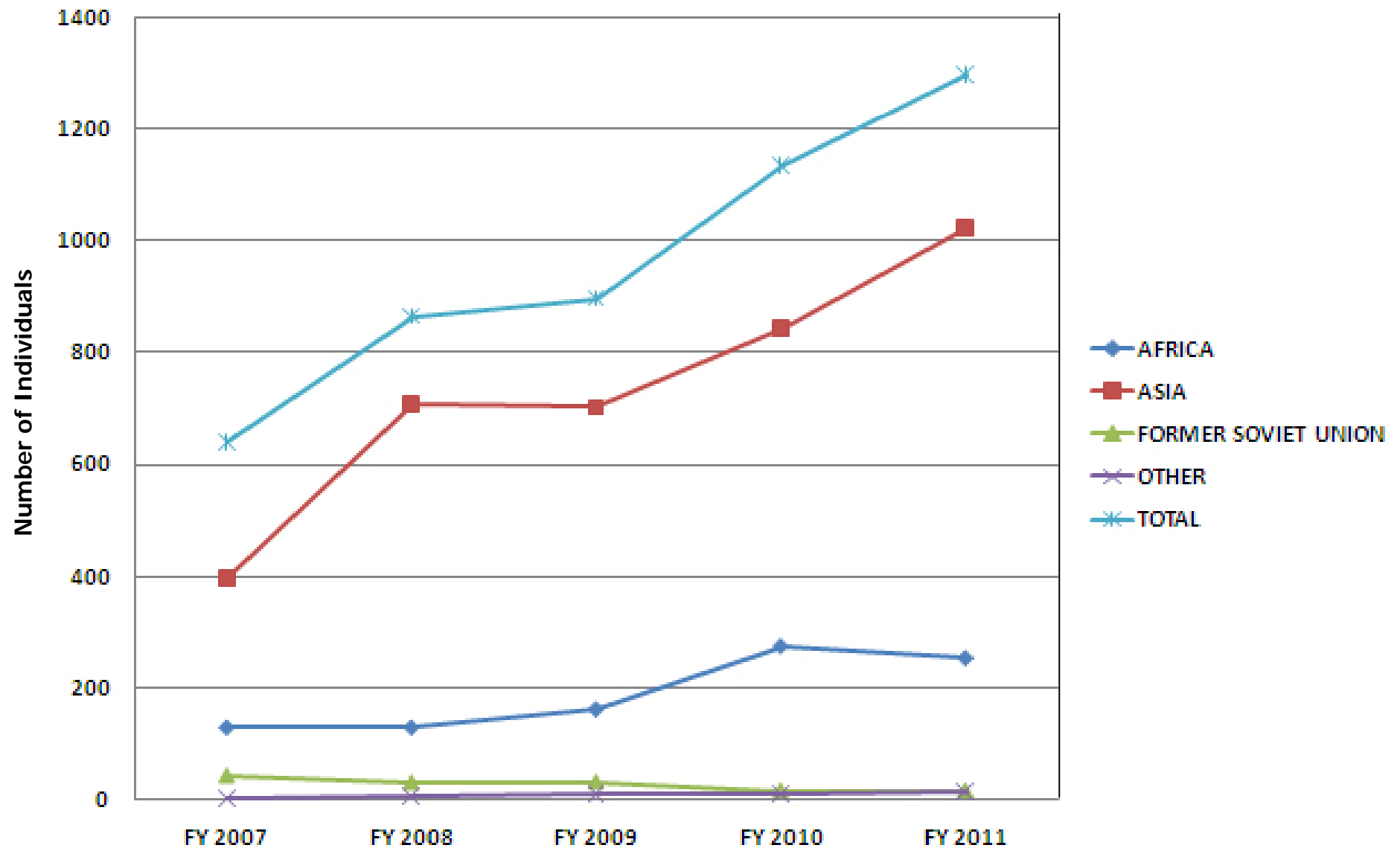

Chart B. Refugee Arrivals to Maryland by Region of Origin FY 2007 - FY 2011

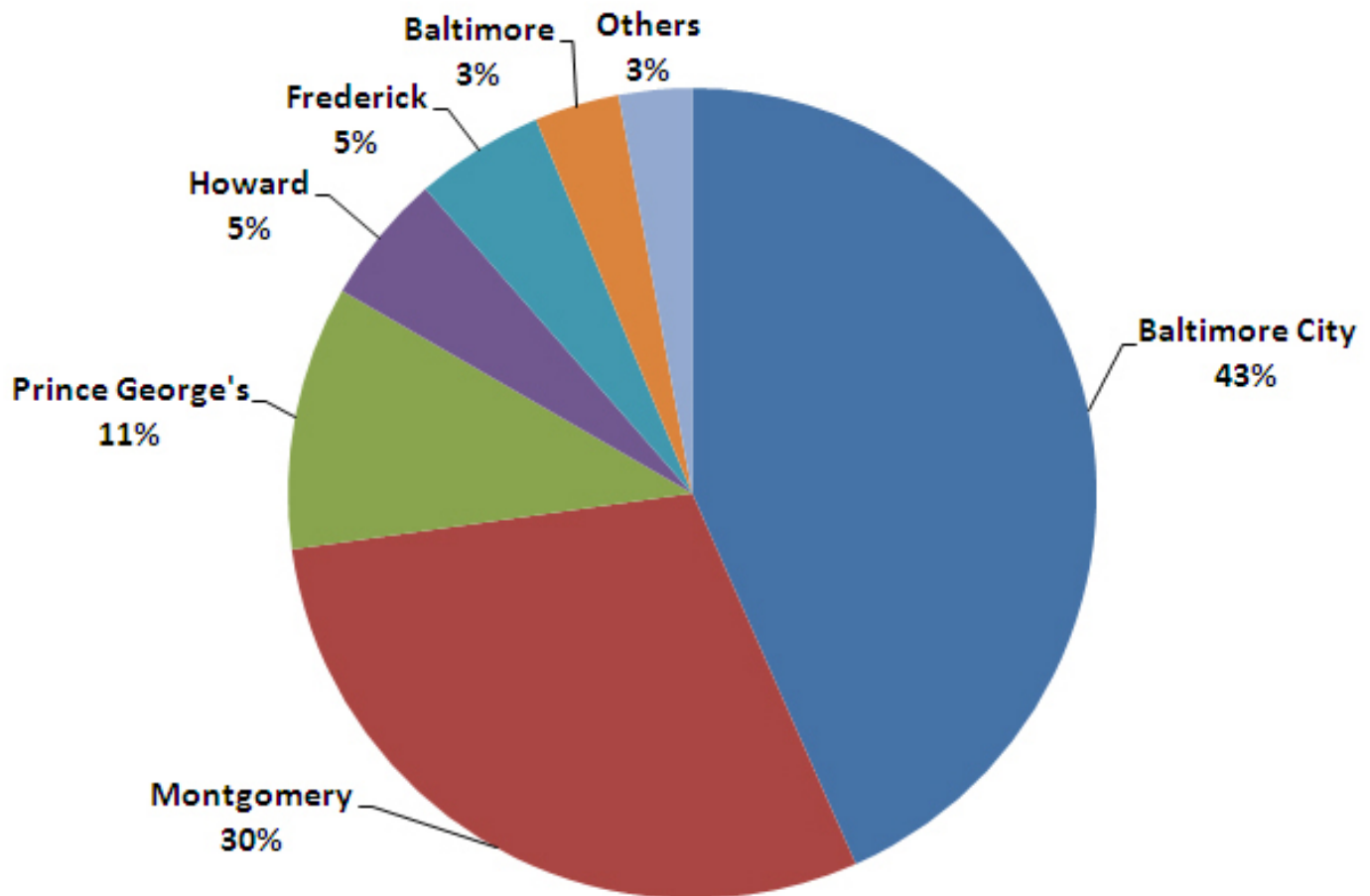

FY 2007 - FY 2011

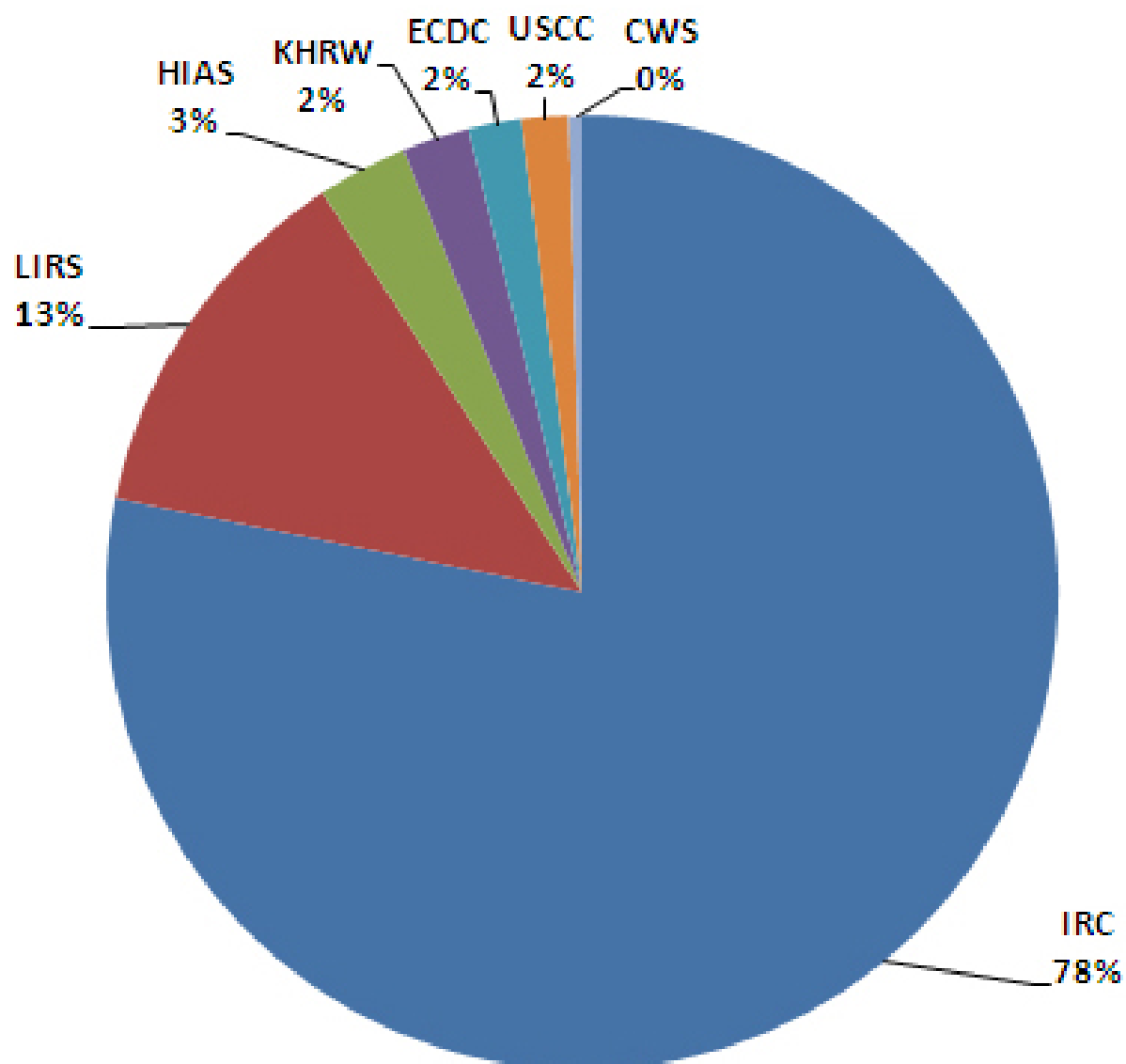

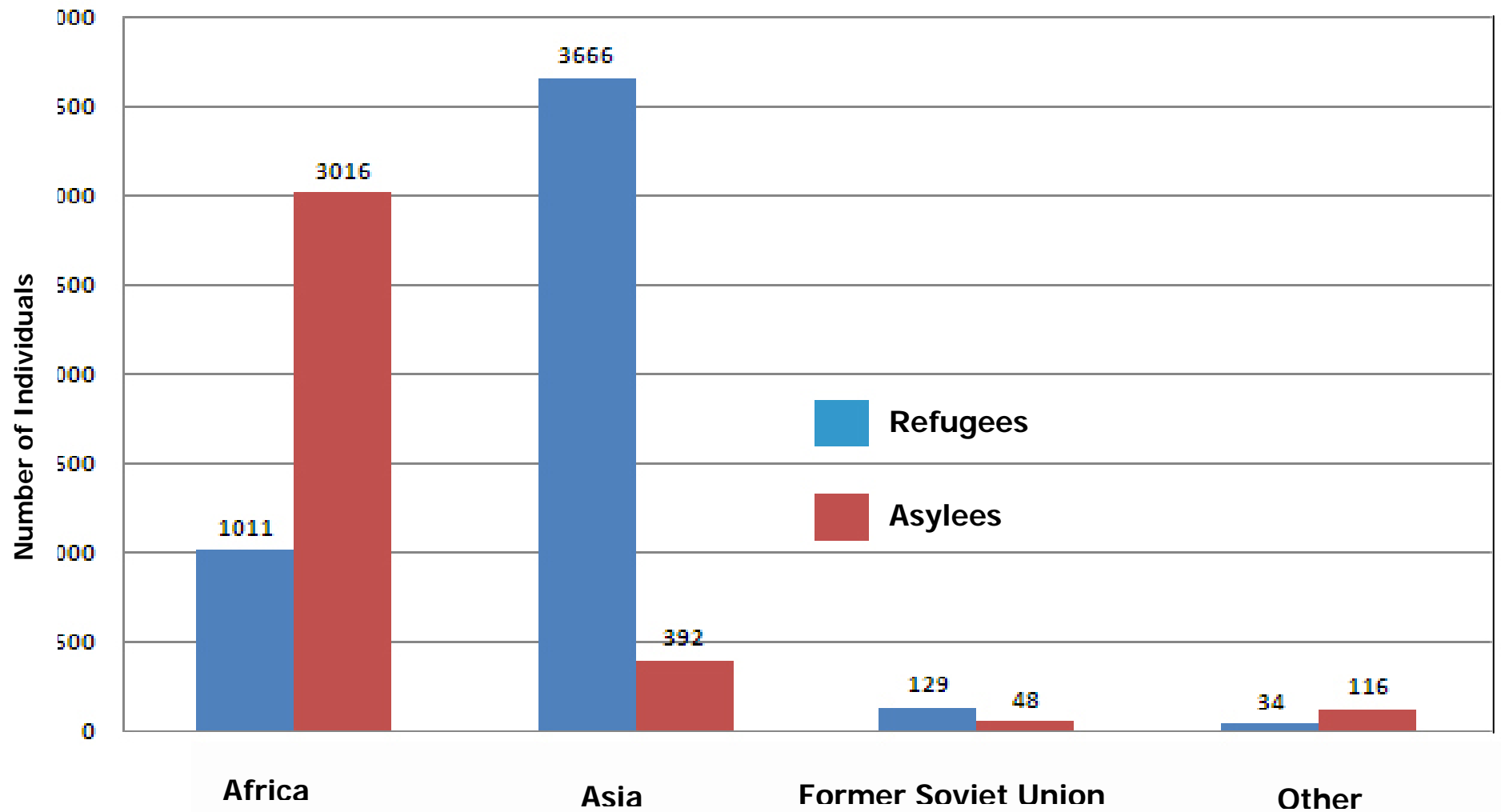
Chart D. Refugee Arrivals to Maryland by County of Residence FY 2007 - FY 2011



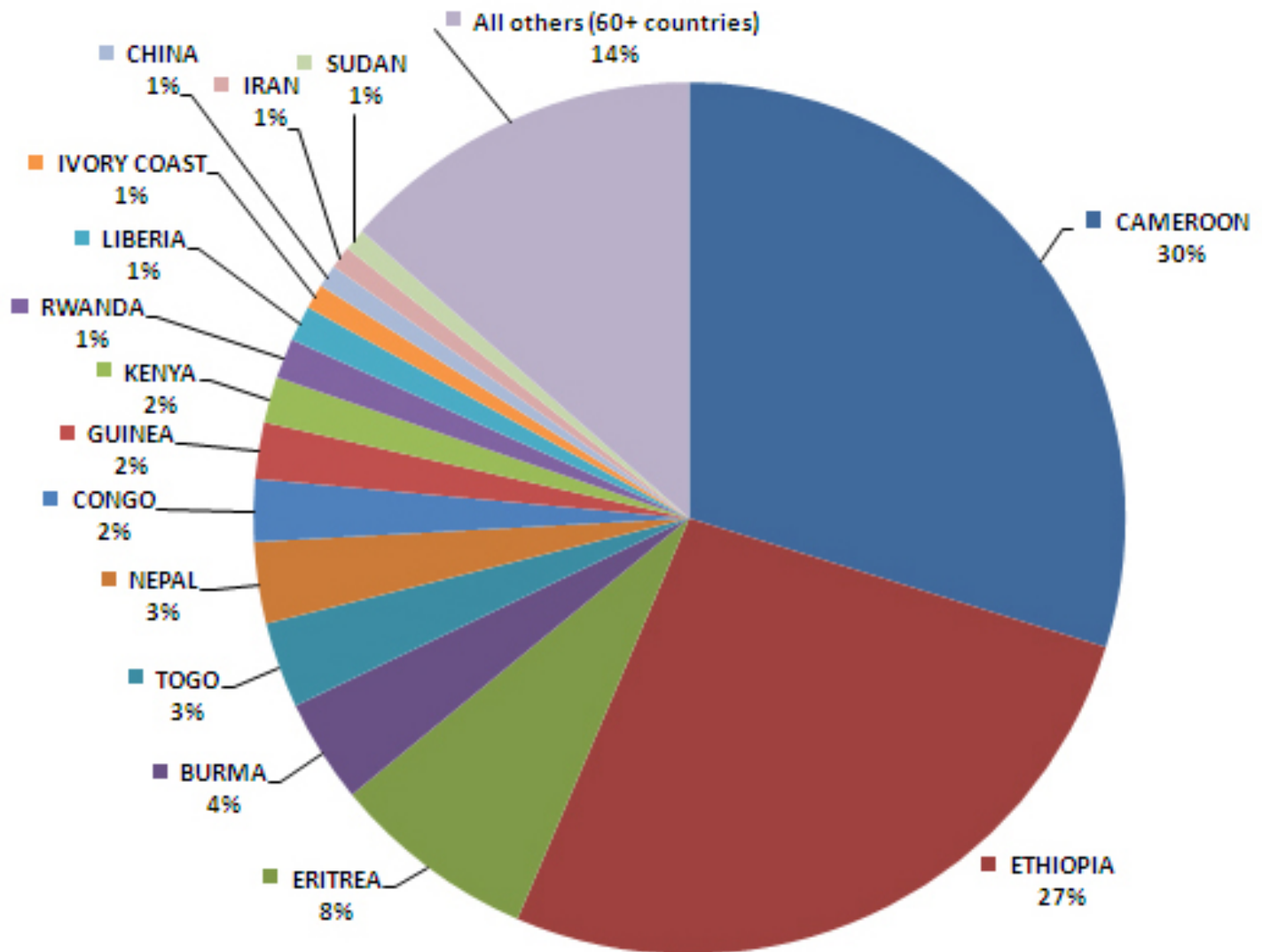

FY 2007 - FY 2011



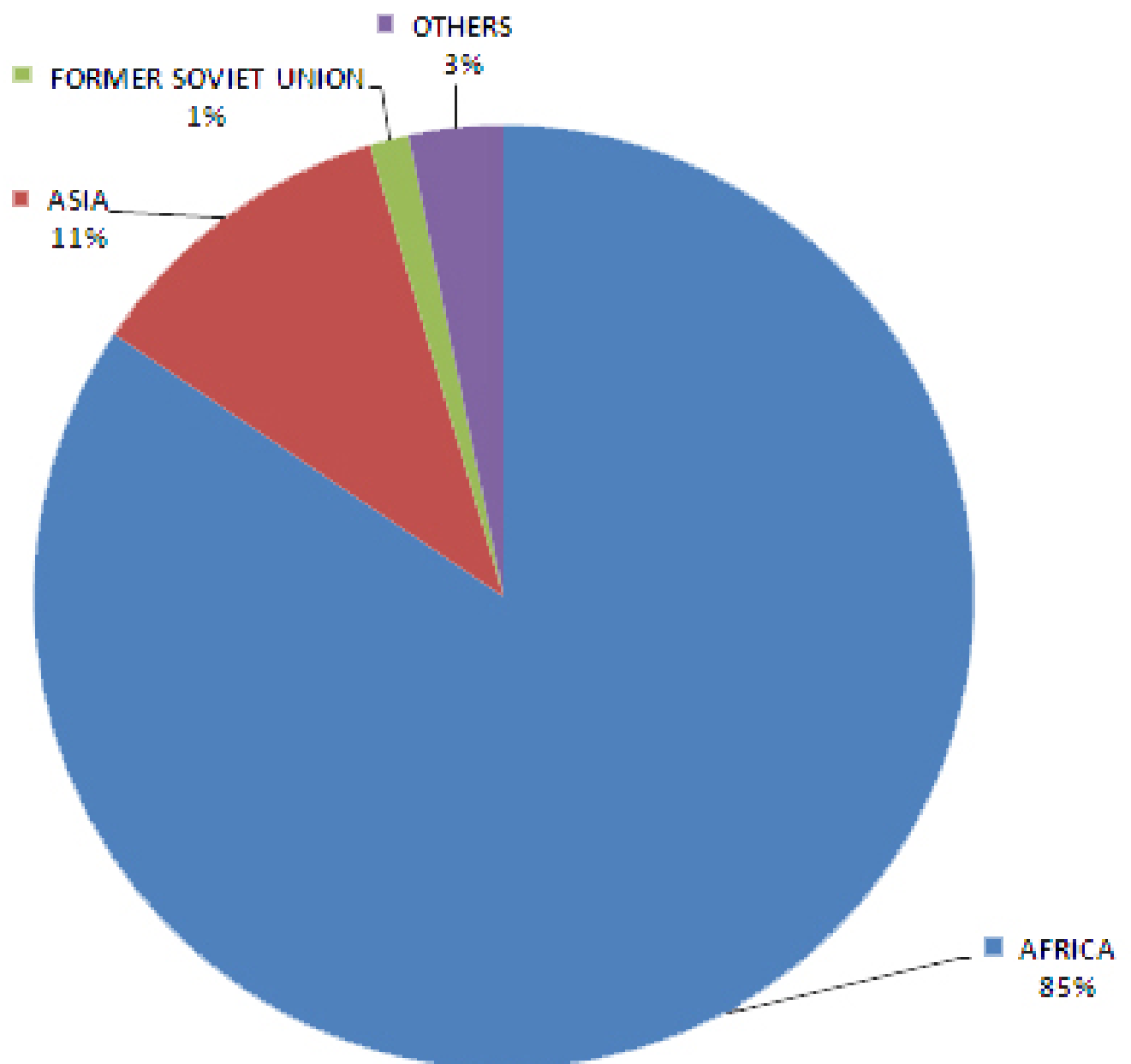

FY 2007 - FY 2011



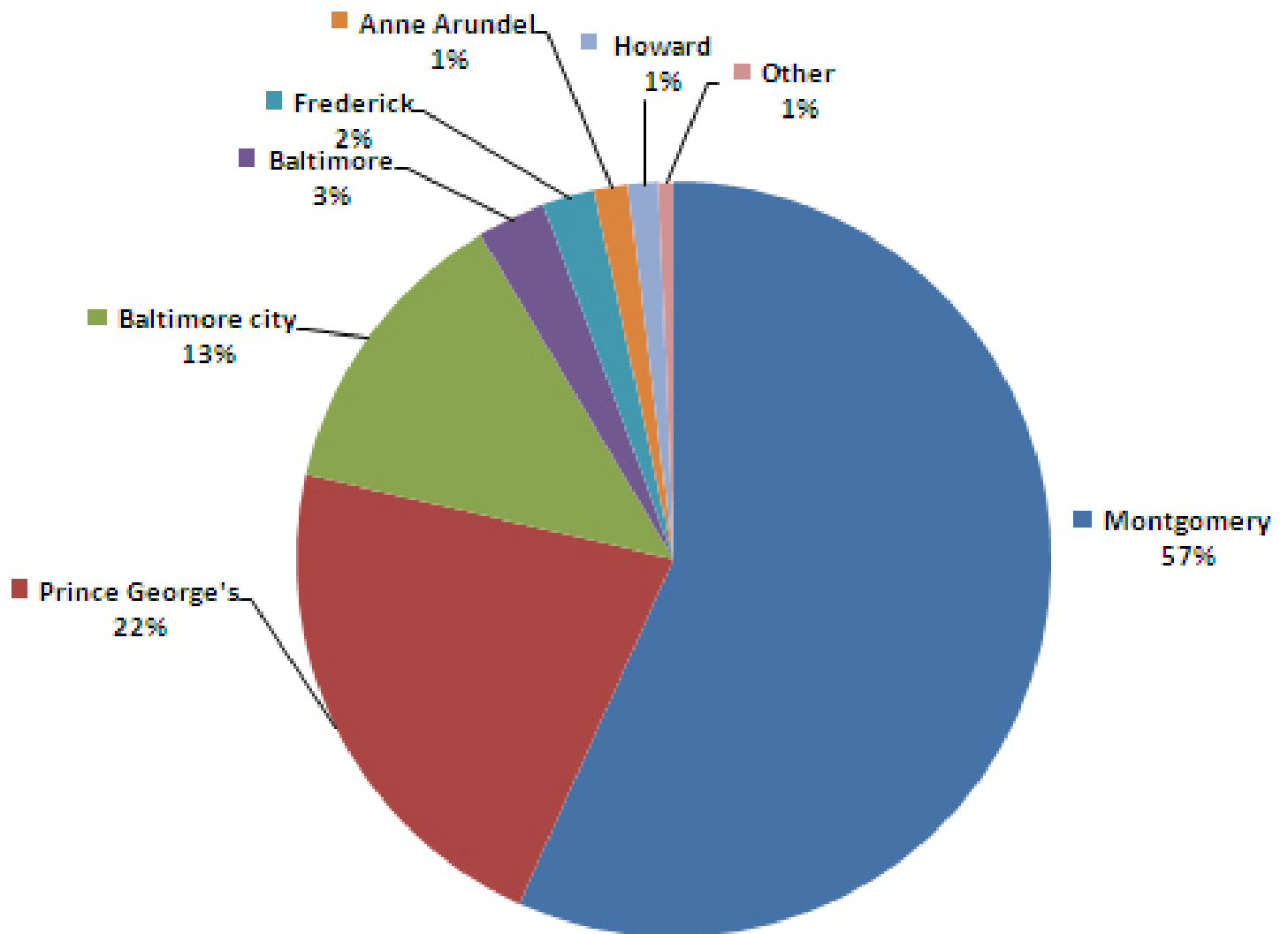

FY 2007 - FY 2011



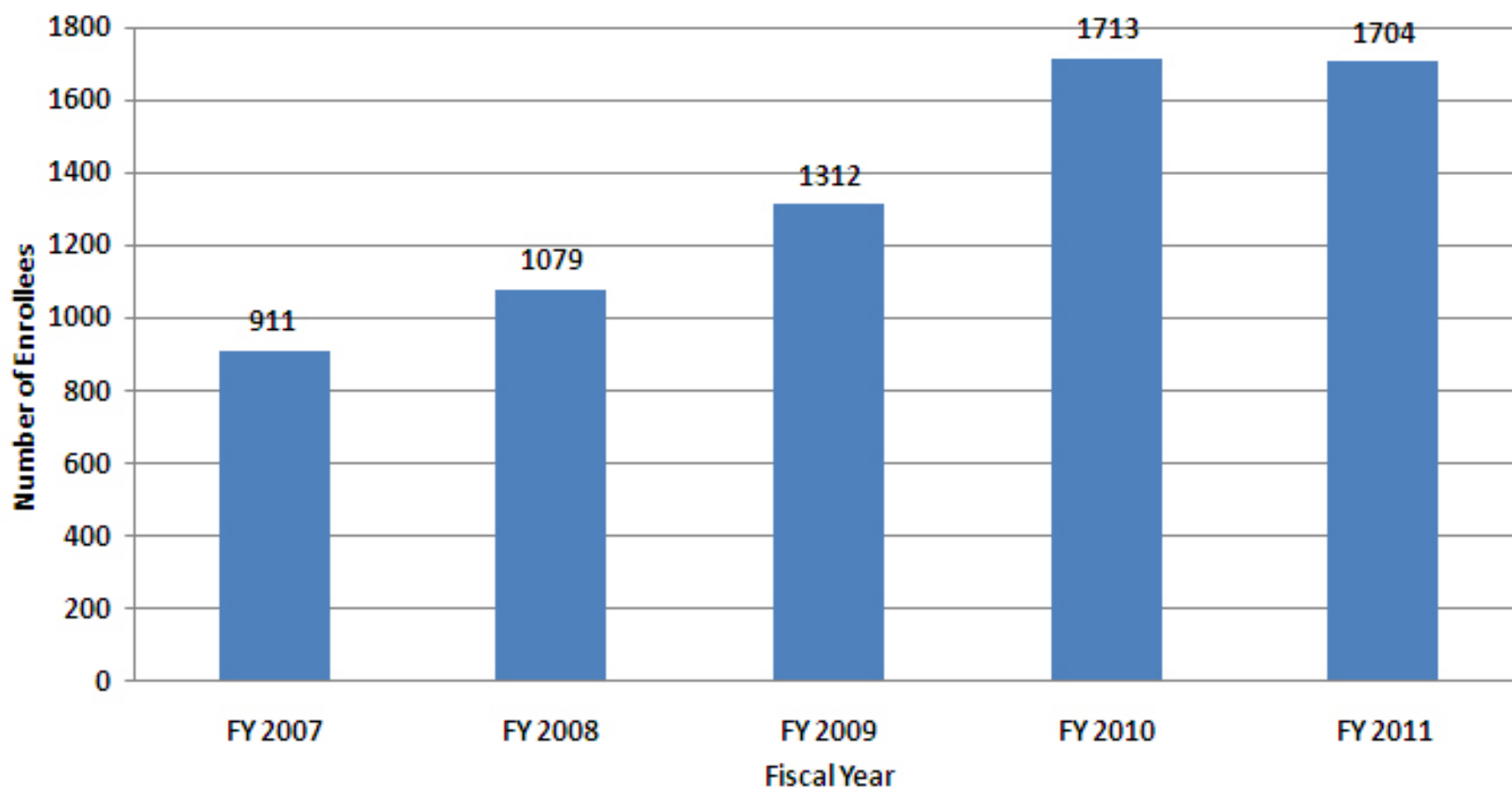

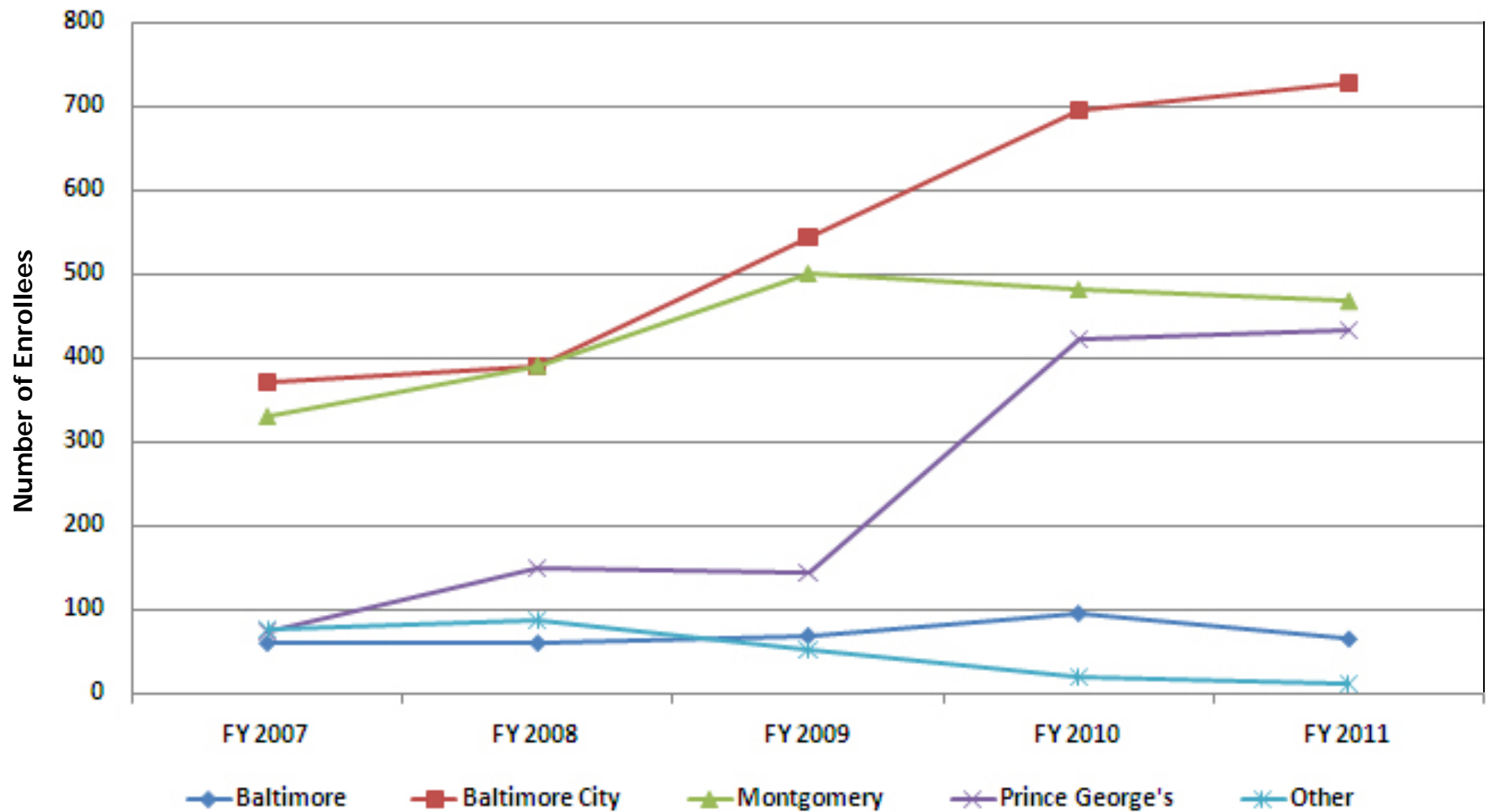

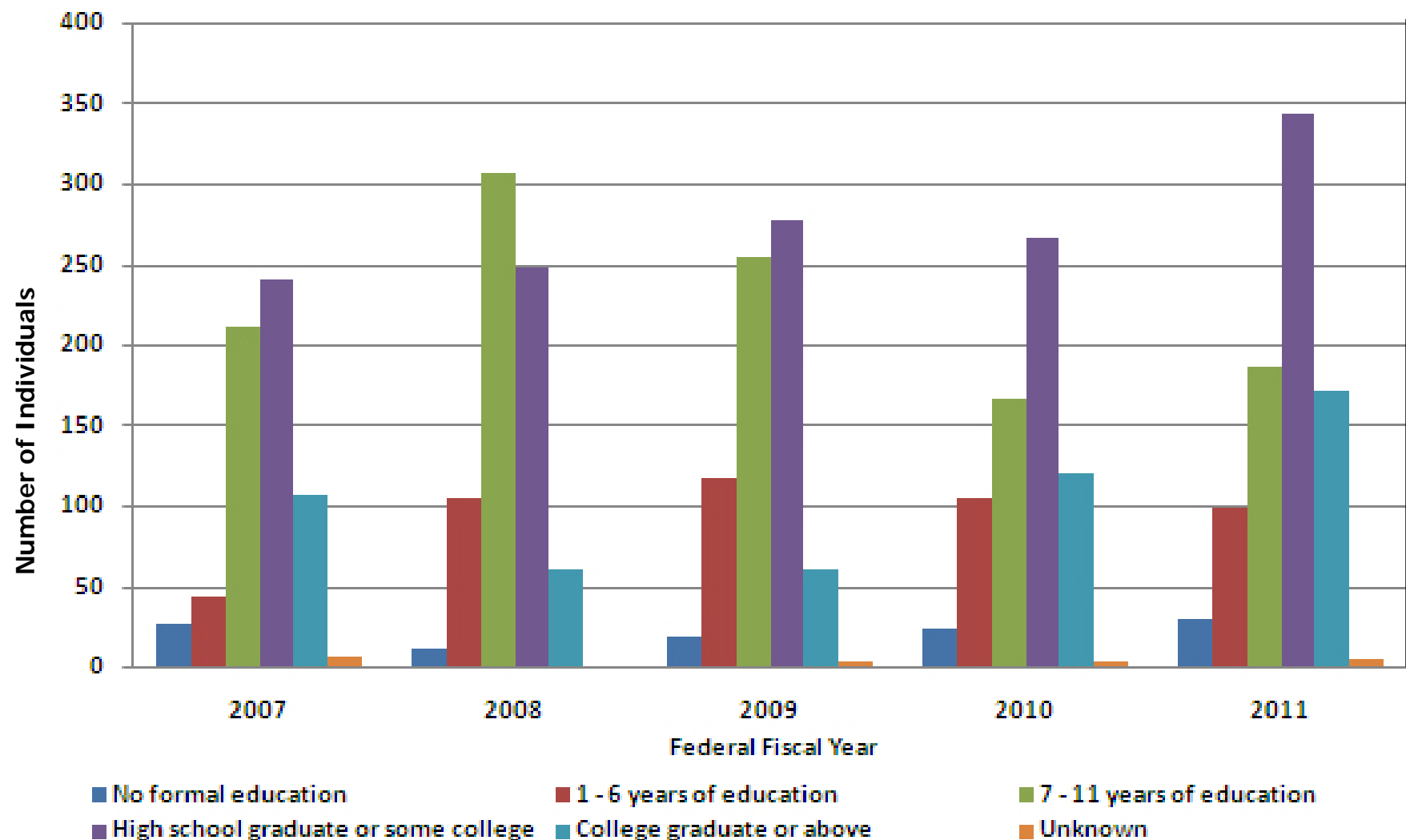

FY 2007 - FY 2011



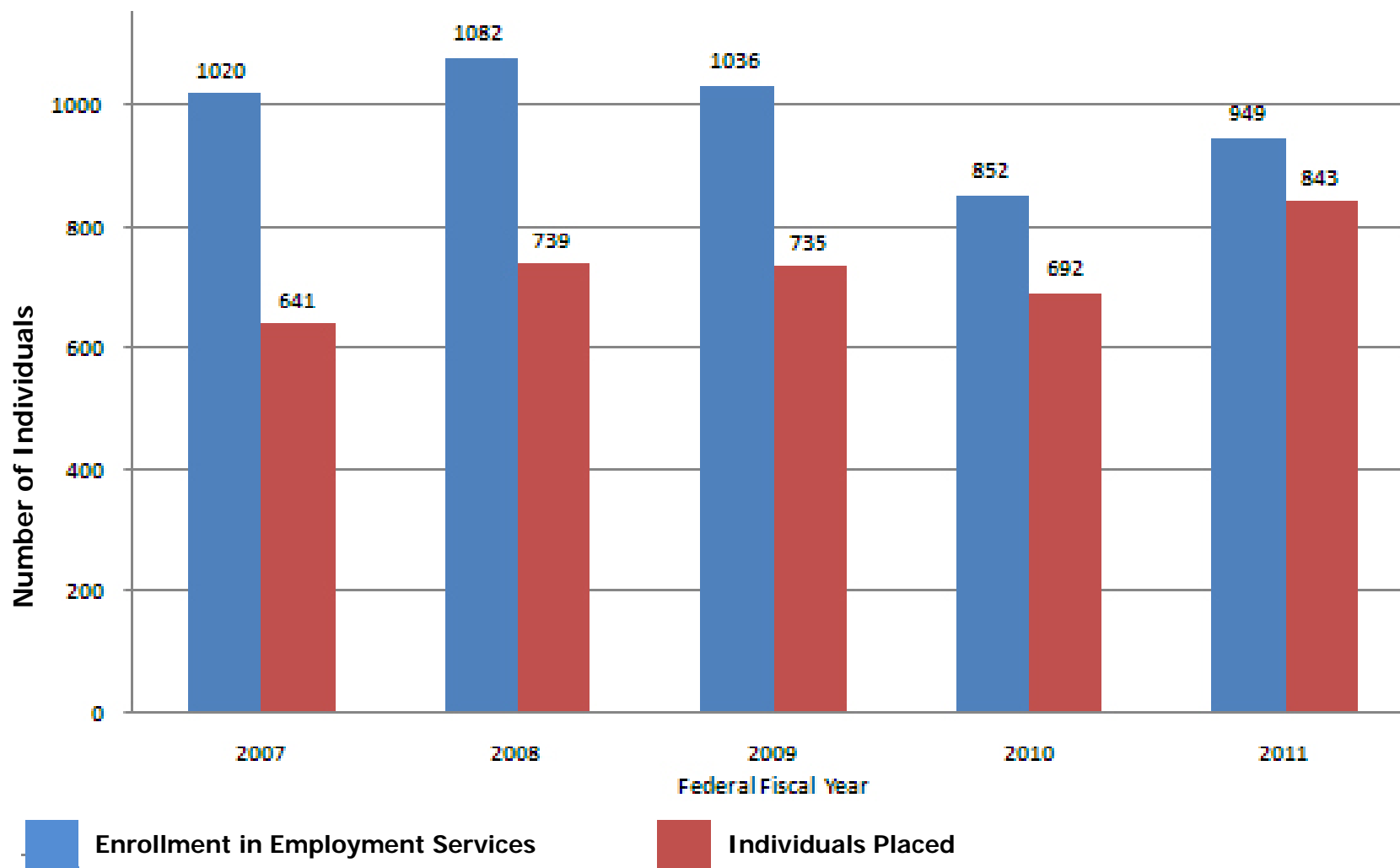

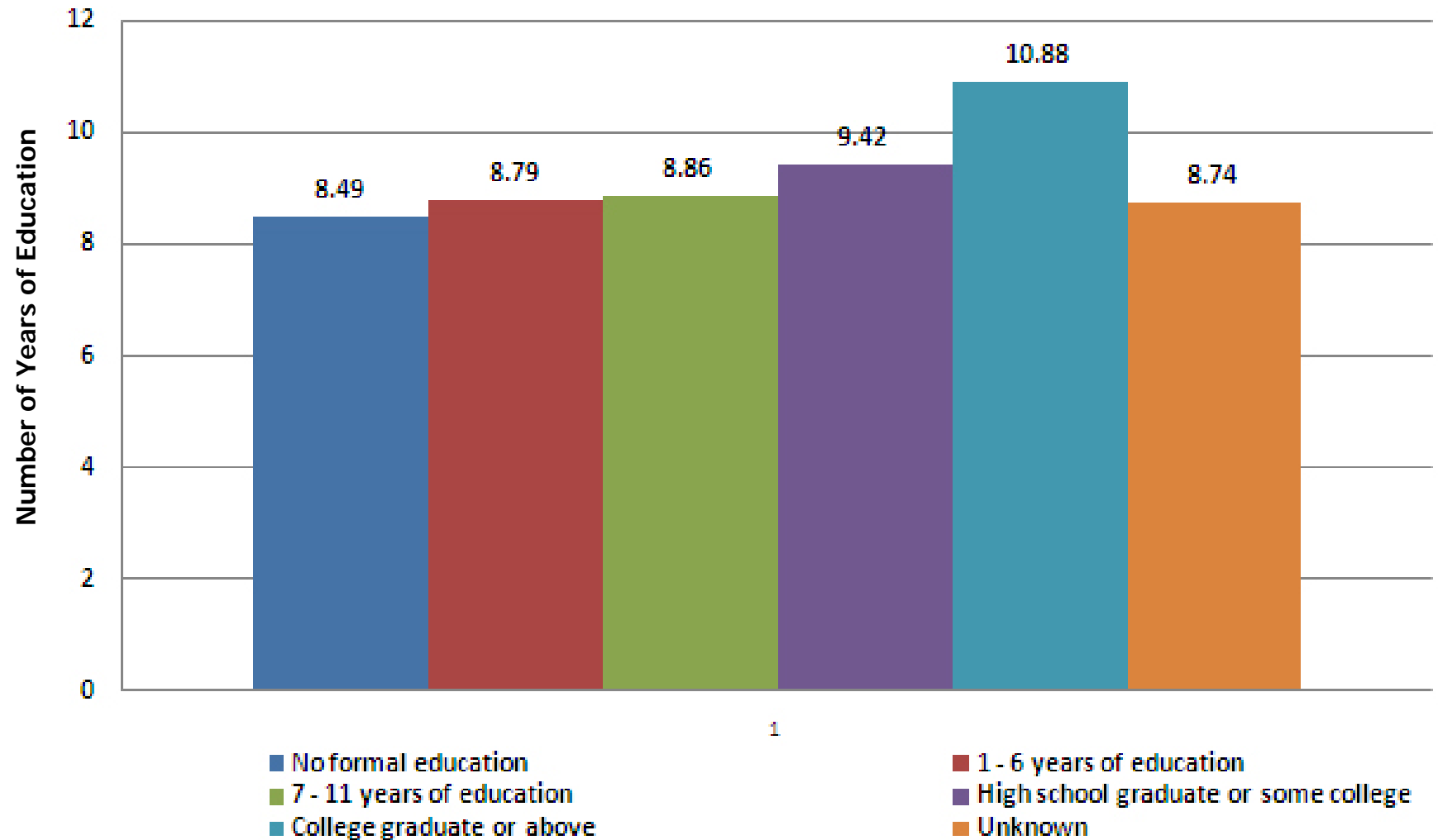

FY 2007 - FY 2011



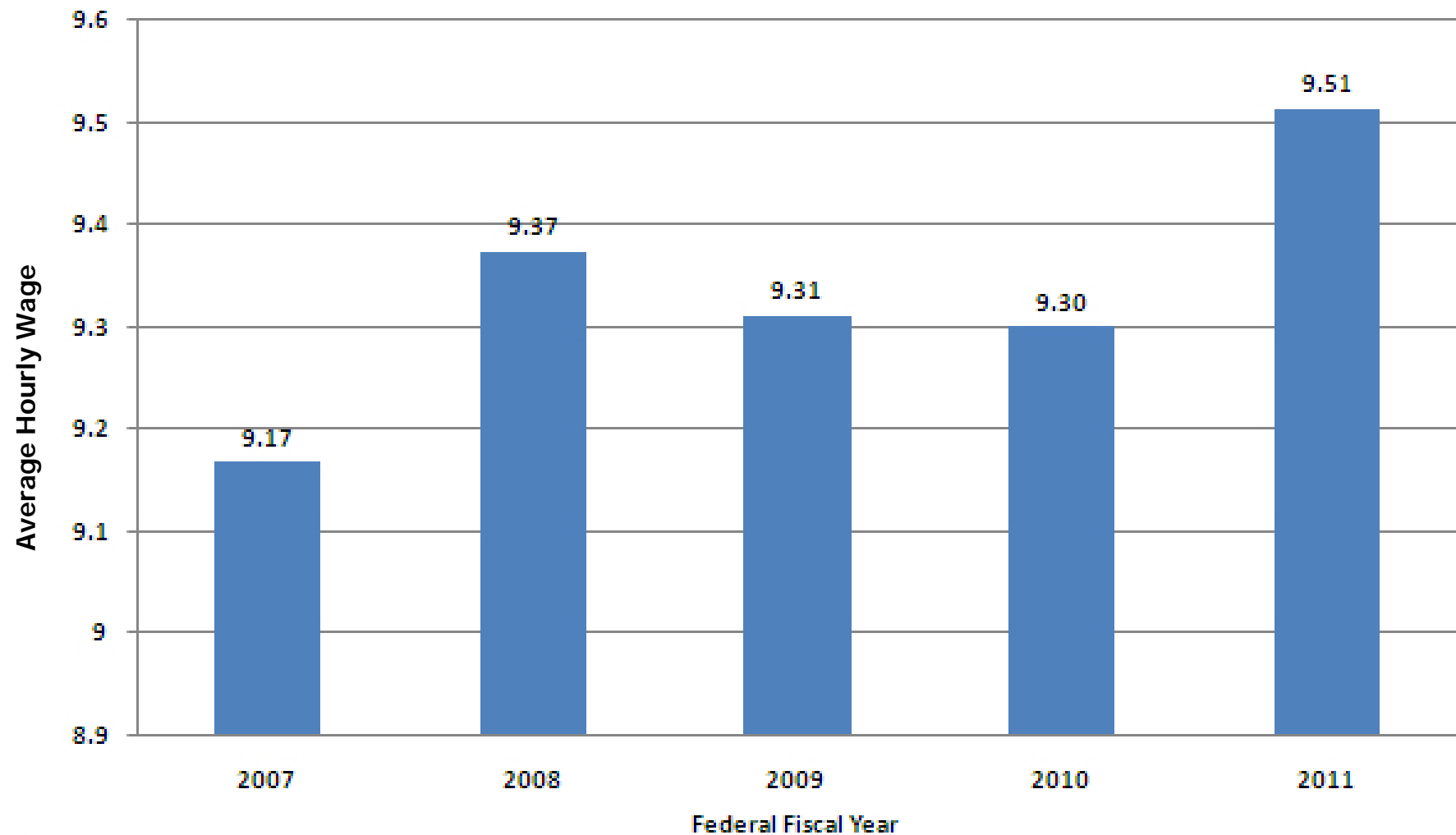

FY 2007 - FY 2011



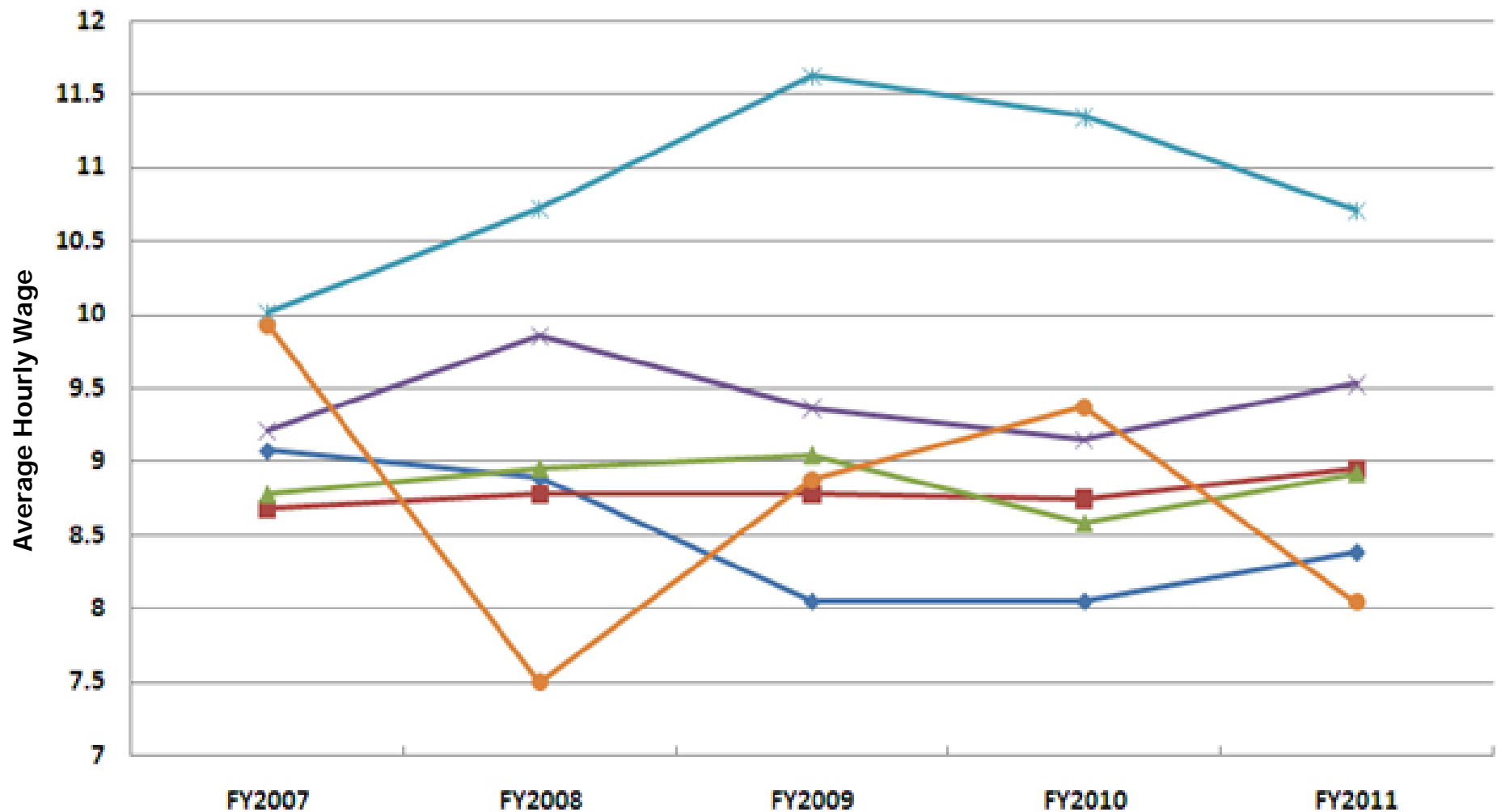

FY 2007 - FY 2011



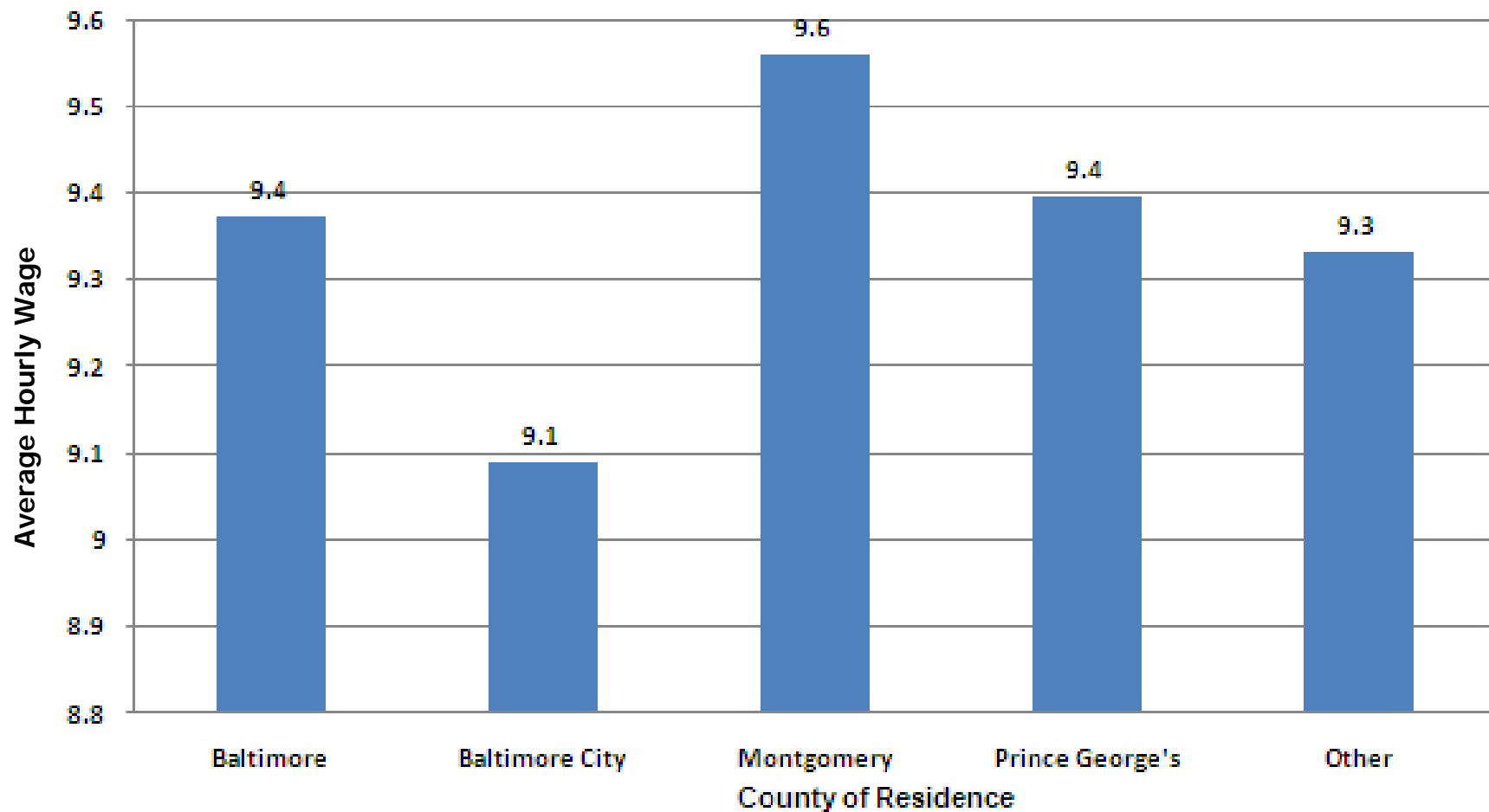

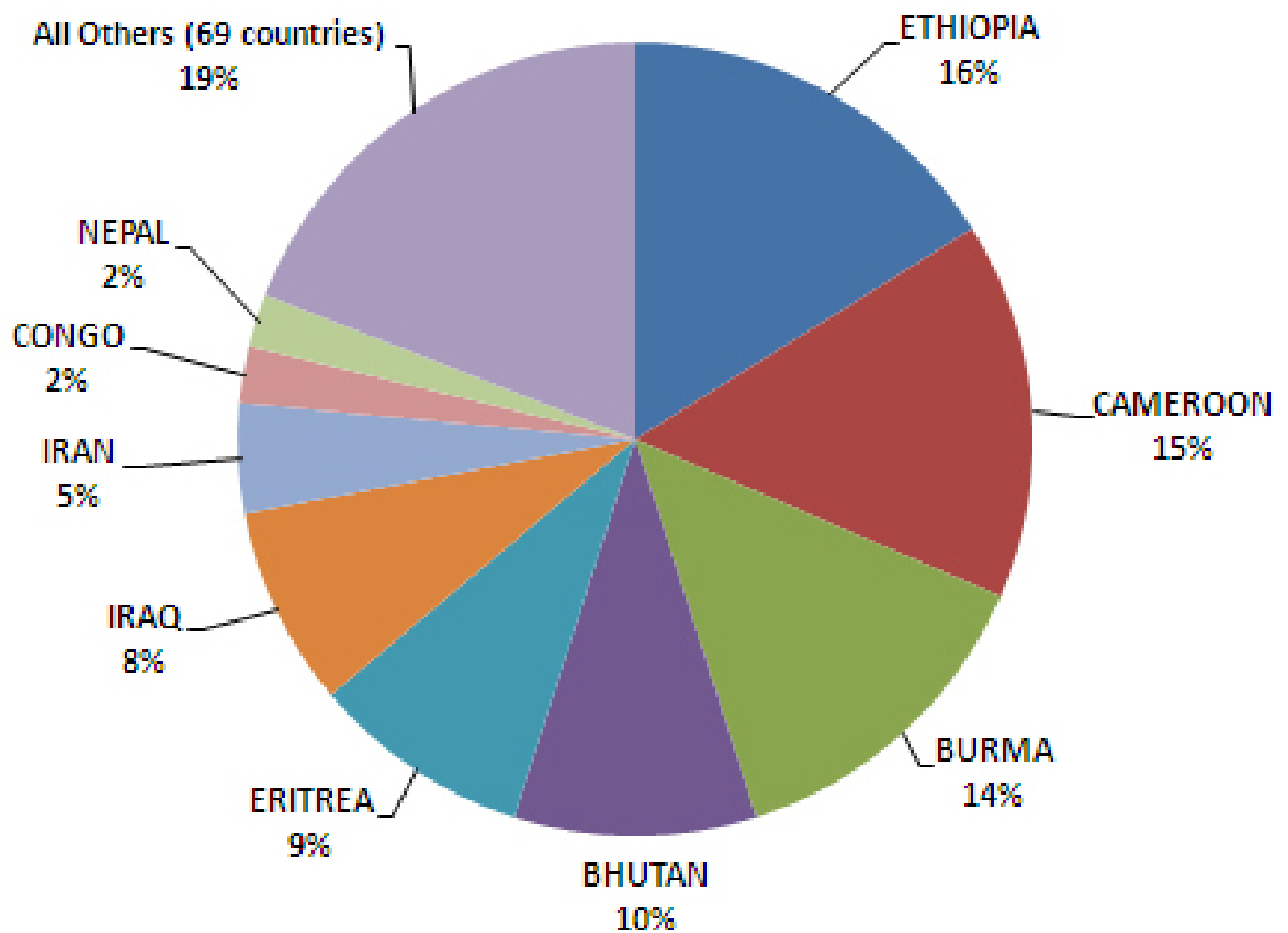

FY 2007 - FY 2011



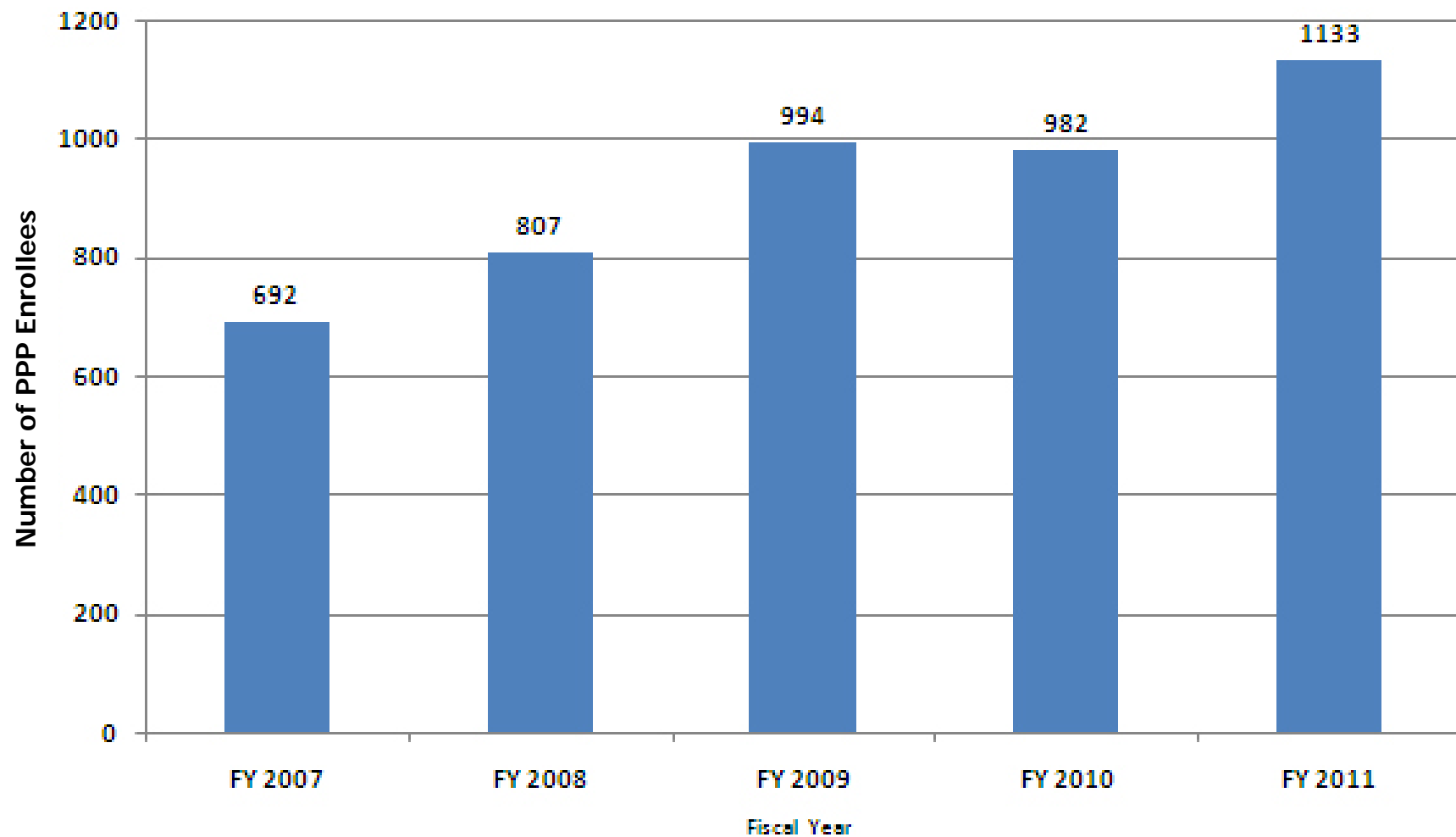

FY 2007 - FY 2011



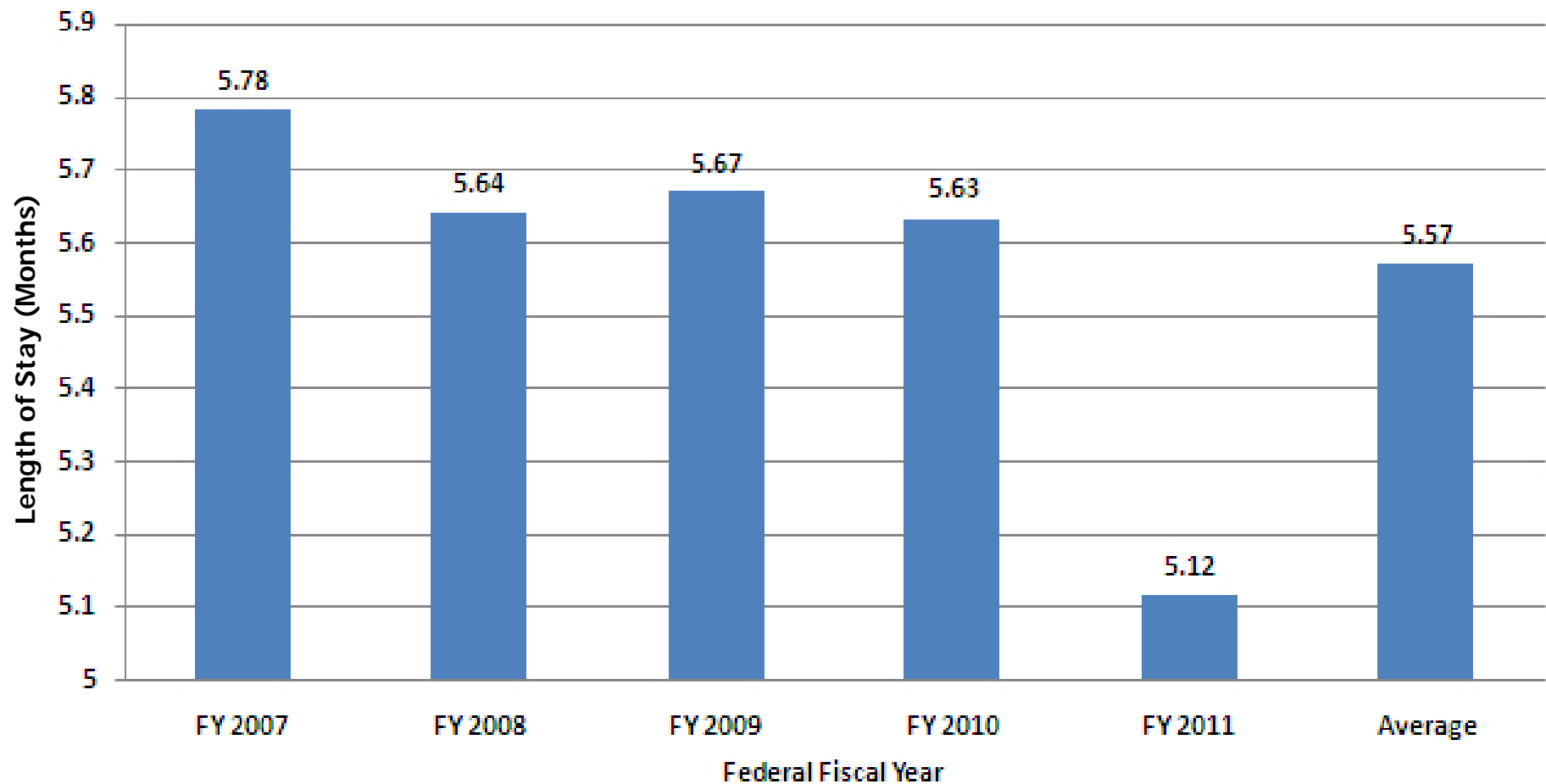

FY 2007 - FY 2011



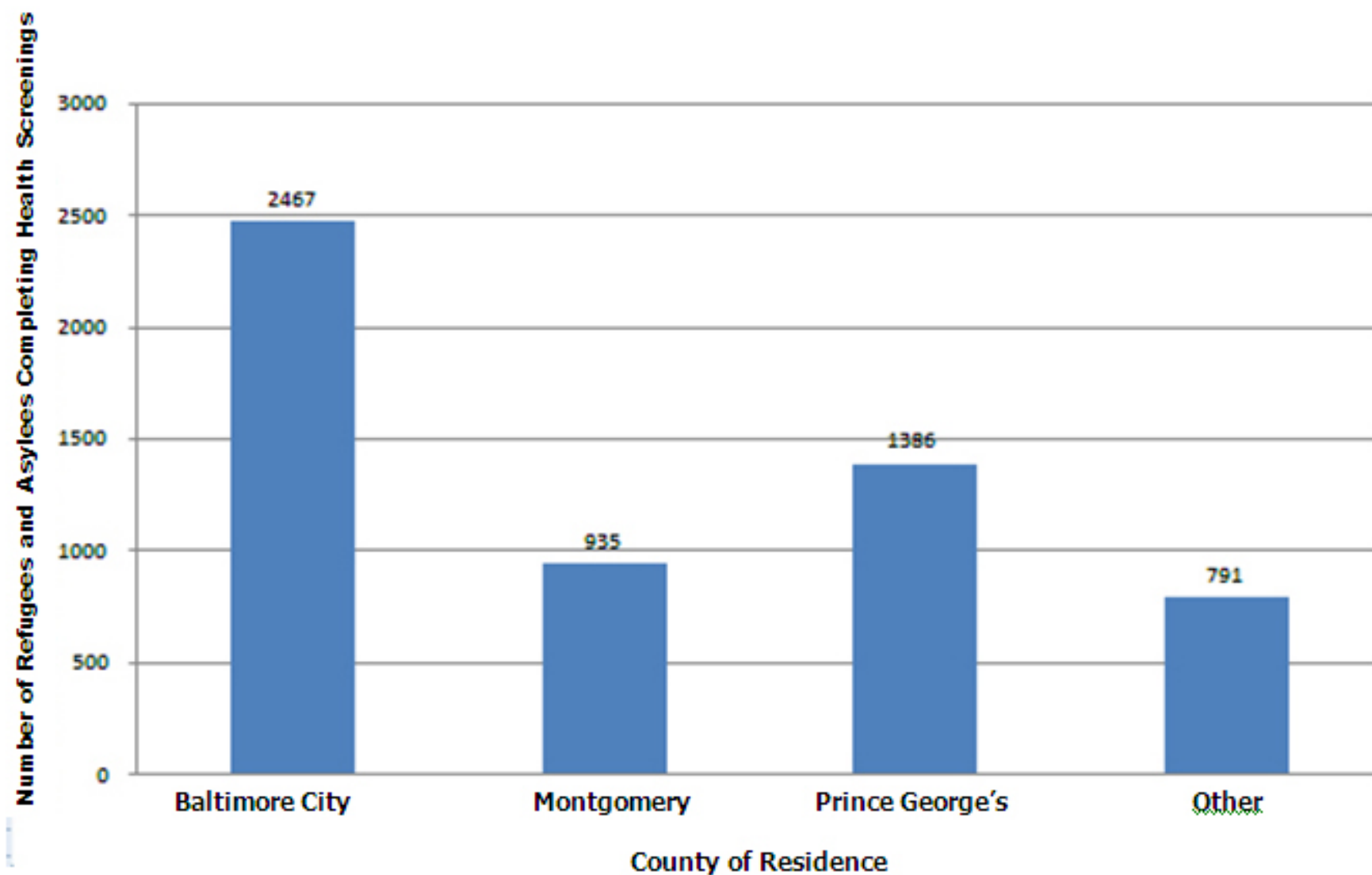
